He has received many awards including the 1982 Best in Show, Watercolor, Contributing Members Show, Rockport Art Assoc., Rockport, Mass., 1983 Maurice E. Goldberg Memorial Prize, Watercolor, Rockport Art Assoc., 1984 Lester Stevens Memorial Award, Watercolor, Academic Artists Assoc., Springfield, MA., 1985 Emile Gruppe Award, oil, Rockport Art Assoc., Rockport, MA., and the 1986 Salmagundi Club Award, Oil, Hudson Valley Artists, New York, N.
